COMMENT: The Rotary Club of Porterville and Porterville Chamber of Commerce are requesting approval to hold the annual Children's Christmas Parade along Main Street on Thursday, November 29, 2018, from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. This application is being submitted under the Community Civic Event Ordinance No. 1326, as amended. The following closures are requested:

**STREETS (5:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.)**

Main Street from Danner Avenue to Olive Avenue;  
Olive Avenue, Morton Avenue, Harrison Avenue, Thurman Avenue, Putnam Avenue, Mill Avenue, Cleveland Avenue (not blocking street for fire access), and Oak Avenue from Hockett Street to Second Street;  
Garden Avenue from Main Street to Second Street;  
Second Street from Olive Avenue to Oak Avenue;  
School Avenue, Belleview Avenue, North Avenue and Doris Avenue, from Main Street to Second Street to Division Street east and Sunnyside Street west.

**SIDEWALKS (5:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.)**

Main Street from Danner Avenue to Olive Avenue and Olive Avenue from Main Street to Second Street

**PARKING SPACES**

Main Street in front of Chamber of Commerce

**(6:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m.)**

Main Street, north end, in front of City hall

**(3:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.)**

The closure of Main Street at 5:00 p.m. will require the early closure of the Fixed Route Transit System at 4:30 p.m., instead of the usual 7:00 p.m., on November 29, 2018. Staff is requesting that Council authorize the change in schedule for the Fixed Route system only.

Early closure of the parking spaces in front of City Hall is requested from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. for placement of the announcer's stand. This will adversely affect City Hall patrons. This conflict is resolved by placing the announcer's

stand at the north end of City Hall along Main Street.

This application has been routed according to the ordinance regulations and has been reviewed by all departments involved. The requirements are listed on the attached copy of the Application and Agreement, Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council:

1. Approve the attached Community Civic Event application and agreement submitted by the Porterville Chamber of Commerce and Rotary Club of Porterville, subject to the Restrictions and Requirements contained in the Application and Agreement, Exhibit A and Exhibit B of the Community Civic Event Application;
2. Authorize the temporary suspension of the Fixed Route Transit System from 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on November 29, 2018; and
3. Restrict the closure of parking spaces in front of City Hall from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., to those at the north end of City Hall along Main Street.

## APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT FOR A PERMIT TO HOLD A COMMUNITY CIVIC EVENT OR OTHER ACTIVITY TO BE HELD ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

**What constitutes a Community Civic Event?**

A non-profit organization wishes to sponsor an event that is open to the community at large and will utilize public property. Most of the time, Community Civic Events require street or sidewalk closures. This application must be submitted **NO LESS THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR** to the date of the event in order to obtain City Council approval.

**All City Code requirements** are described in ordinance 15-20 (e) 1-23 and as amended in ordinance 1613. For a full description please visit our City of Porterville website at [www.ci.porterville.ca.us/govt/CityClerk/](http://www.ci.porterville.ca.us/govt/CityClerk/), Porterville Municipal Codes. For questions or concerns please call 559-782-7451 or 559-782-7457. Any person who violates the provisions in this code, shall be deemed guilty of either a misdemeanor or an infraction, with penalties of one hundred (\$100) for the first violation.

**Liability insurance:** The sponsoring organization/applicant agrees to provide and keep in force during the term of this permit a policy of liability and property damage insurance against liability for personal injury, including accidental death, as well as liability for property damage which may arise in any way during the term of this permit. The City of Porterville and Successor Agency to the Porterville Redevelopment Agency shall be named as additional insured. A Certificate of Liability Insurance and Additional Insured Endorsement sample forms are enclosed for your convenience. This original certificate and endorsement shall be submitted to the Finance Department prior to the City of Porterville Council's approval. *The council shall condition the granting of a CCE permit upon the sponsoring entity's filing with the council a policy of public liability insurance in which the city has been named as insured or coinsured with the permittee. The policy of insurance shall insure the city, its officers, and its employees against all claims arising out of, or in connection with, the issuance of the CCE permit or the operation of the permittee or its agents or representatives, pursuant to the permit. The policy of insurance shall provide coverage of no less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence of bodily injury and property damage, combined single limit. (Ordinance 15-20(e) 18)*

(AP) Authorized Representative Initial

**Alcohol liability insurance:** Organization/Applicant will obtain an alcohol permit if any alcoholic beverages are to be served. The insurance policy shall be endorsed to include full liquor liability in an amount not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence. The City of Porterville shall be named as additional insured against all claims arising out of or in connection with the issuance of this permit or the operation of the permitted, his/her agents or representatives pursuant the permit. Claims-made policies are not acceptable.

**Health permit:** Organization/Applicant will obtain or ensure that all participants obtain a 'Temporary Food Facilities' permit(s) from the Tulare County Public Health Department, if any food is to be served in connection with this Community Civic Event. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, CA, 93277, call 559-733-6441, or fax information to 559-733-6932; or visit their website: [www.tularehhsa.org](http://www.tularehhsa.org).

(WP) Authorized Representative Initials

**First aid station:** Organization/Applicant will establish a first aid station, with clearly posted signs, to provide basic emergency care, such as ice/hot packs, bandages, and compresses.

(WP) Authorized Representative Initials

**Toilet rental service:** Applicant shall have care, custody and control of the equipment and shall bear responsibility and liability for all loss and damage to the equipment and for its contents while at the City's location. Applicant shall not overload, move or alter the equipment and shall use the equipment for its intended purpose. Applicant shall be responsible for any damages to City's property resulting from company's provision of services hereunder. Applicant shall confirm with the service company the number of portable toilets, standard and handicap, and wash sinks needed for the number of expected attendees.

(WP) Authorized Representative Initials

**Agreement:** The sponsoring organization/applicant agrees to comply with all provisions of the Community Civic Event Ordinance 15-20(e), as amended, and the terms and conditions set forth by City Council and stated in Exhibit 'A.' The sponsoring organization/applicant agrees, during the term of this permit, to secure and hold the City free and harmless from all loss, liability, and claims for damages, costs and charges of any kind or character arising out of, relating to, or in any way connected with his/her performance of this permit. Said agreement to hold harmless shall include and extend to any injury to any person or persons, or property of any kind whatsoever and to whomever belonging, including, but not limited to, said organization/applicant, and shall not be liable to the City for any injury to persons or property which may result solely or primarily from the action or non-action of the City or its directors, officers, or employees. Approval of the Community Civic Events Permit by the Porterville City Council pertains only to authorized activities conducted at designated locations within the incorporated area of the City of Porterville, and such approval shall not be construed or interpreted to authorize sponsor utilization of public right-of-ways outside of the jurisdiction of the City of Porterville.

### RISK MANAGEMENT: Conditions of Approval

That the Rotary Club of Porterville provide a Certificate of Commercial General Liability Insurance Coverage at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form CG 00 01, evidencing coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and having the appropriate Endorsement naming the City of Porterville, its Officers, Officials, Employees, Agents, and Volunteers as Additional Insured for bodily injury and property damage, including without limitation, blanket contractual liability arising from, or in connection with, the Permittee's operation and sponsorship of the aforementioned Community Civic Event. Applicant's general liability policies shall be primary and non-contributory, and be endorsed using Insurance Services Office form CG 20 10.

Said Certificate of Insurance shall be an original (fax and xerographic copies not acceptable), the Certificate shall be signed by an agent authorized to bind insurance coverage with the carrier, and the deductible, if any, shall not be greater than \$1,000.

Said insurance shall be primary to the insurance held by the City of Porterville, be with a company having an A. M. Best Rating of no less than A: VII, and the insurance company must be an admitted insurer in the State of California.

The use of sidewalks, during this event, for any purpose other than normal pedestrian traffic, e.g., food booths, sales booths, displays, bleachers, etc., is prohibited within a ten-foot radius of all walk-up Versa-Teller operations.

Recommendations/Requirements:

- City Council approval is required for all street closures.
- Ensure adequate barricades/barriers are used to warn motorists of non-access and prevent vehicle access to those designated areas.
- Parade Committee should meet with street vendors to coordinate rules regarding their activities, such as:
  - Staying off the parade route and crossing in front of floats or groups
  - Shall not sell silly string, snap caps or party poppers
  - Ensure each vendor has properly obtained a City business license
- Food vendors should be situated where they minimally block the sidewalk.
- Food vendors should provide inspection certificates from the Tulare County Health Department to ensure safe food products.
- Throwing candy from vehicles, floats, or any parade entry is prohibited. This results in children scampering to catch or find candy in a crowded environment, and causes others to run out into the street. This practice creates significant and unnecessary risk for parade goers. All registered parade entrants should be informed of this prohibition and efforts taken to cease this practice.
- An Outside Amplifier Permit has been requested and granted. However, event organizers shall not allow music or other amplifications to be played so loud as to unreasonably disturb the peace and good order of the business establishments or neighborhoods in the area.
- Event organizers shall coordinate all policing/traffic/parking/posting concerns with Lt. Josh Maniss or Lt. Brian Nix well in advance of the event. They can be contacted at 559-782-7410/559-782-7400.

Section 18-9

It shall be unlawful for any person within the city to use or operate or cause to be operated or to play any radio, phonograph, jukebox, record player, loudspeaker, musical instrument, mechanical device, machine, apparatus, or instrument for intensification or amplification of the human voice or any sound or noise in a manner so loud as to be calculated to disturb the peace and good order of the neighborhood or sleep of ordinary persons in nearby residences or so loud as to unreasonably disturb and interfere with the peace and comfort of the occupants of nearby residences.

The operation of any such instrument, phonograph, jukebox, machine or device in such manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of one hundred feet (100') from the building, structure, vehicle, or place in which, or on which it is situated or located shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section. (Ord. Code § 6311)

Section 18-14

It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain, operate, connect, or suffer or permit to be maintained, operated, or operated, or connected any or sound amplifier in such a manner as to cause any sound to be projected outside of any building or out of doors in any part of the city, except as may be necessary to amplify sound for the proper presentation of moving picture shows, or exhibiting for the convenient hearing of patrons within the building or enclosure in which the show or exhibition is given, without having first procured a permit from the chief of police, which permit shall be granted at the will of the chief of police upon application in writing therefore, but which permit, when granted, shall be revocable by the city council whenever any such loudspeaker or sound amplifier shall by the council be deemed objectionable, and any such permit may be so revoked with or without notice, or with or without a formal hearing, at the option of the council, and in the event of the revocation of any such permit, the same shall not be renewed, except upon application as the first instance. (Ord. Code § 6312)

Penal Code Section 415 (2) Any of the following persons shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not more than 90 days, a fine of not more than four hundred dollars (\$400), or both such imprisonment and fine: (2) Any person who maliciously and willfully disturbs another person by loud and unreasonable noise.

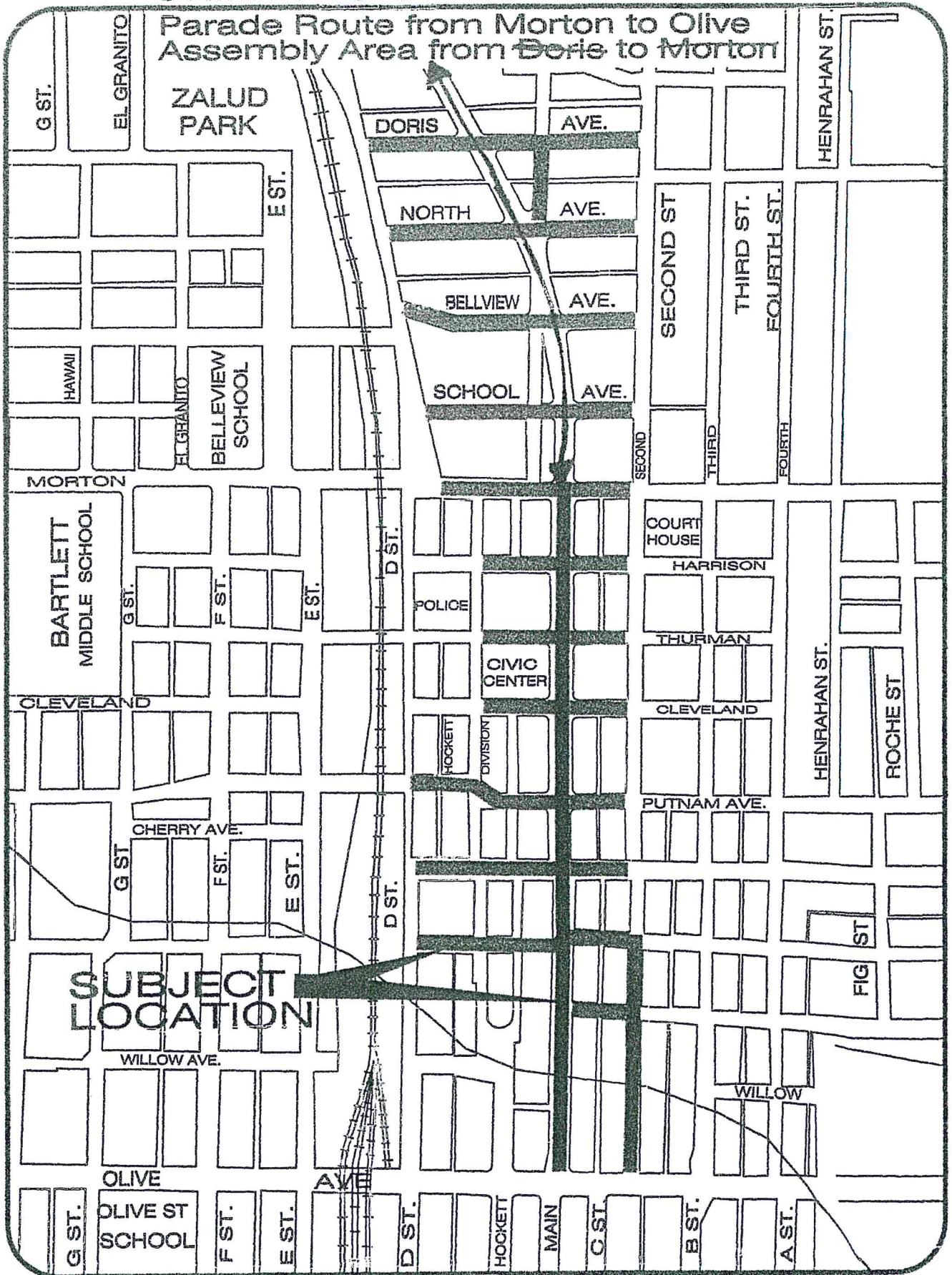



SUBJECT: Discussion Pertaining to the Prospective Relocation of Eagle Mountain Casino

SOURCE: City Manager's Office

COMMENT: The Tule River Tribe and the City of Porterville have a long-appreciated and well-established relationship of mutual respect and collaboration, which has manifested itself in recent years in services to the benefit of both their constituents. For more than the past five (5) years, the City has administered and provided transit service to the Reservation, providing valuable transit connection for the residents of the Reservation to services in Porterville, and Porterville residents to services (education, employment, medical and recreational) on the Reservation as well. Given their shared reverence for our great nation, the City and Tribe have partnered together to offer the Porterville community the annual Freedom Fest, an annual fireworks and community celebration of our country's freedom and independence. The Tribe is integrally involved in the Porterville community, operating a successful restaurant, involved in the Chamber of Commerce, and significantly supporting many local community organizations.

For more than the past decade, the Tribe has considered the relocation of the Eagle Mountain Casino to the 40-acre property it owns west of the Porterville Airport, which is currently being considered by the Department of the Interior-Bureau of Indian Affairs. As part of the proposed relocation, there are several additional opportunities for continued collaboration, including potential community fire response, wastewater tertiary treatment, and airport and community promotion and tourism. This Special Meeting of the City Council and Tribal Council provides the bodies the opportunity to engage in dialogue and discussion in regards to the prospect that the relocation of Eagle Mountain Casino is eventually a reality.
