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CITY COUNCIL AGENDA – DECEMBER 8, 2020

SUBJECT: Acceptance of Official Canvass of Votes for November 3, 2020, Election

SOURCE: Administrative Services

COMMENT: On November 3, 2020, a municipal election was held for the purpose of electing individuals to the available four-year term City Council Offices in District 3 and District 5. Additionally, two proposed tax measures - Measures R and S - were also on the ballot. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 9 of the City Charter, after any municipal election, the elections official must duly canvass the returns and declare the results thereof. The City's election was conducted as a consolidated general election with election services provided by Tulare County. Pursuant to Elections Code, the County Registrar of Voters conducted its official canvass and has presented the results thereof.

Pursuant to the certified results, incumbent candidate Martha A. Flores was reelected in District 3 with 1,554 votes; and candidate Kellie Carrillo was elected in District 5 with 1,086 votes. Due to only one candidate, incumbent candidate Monte Reyes, qualified and filed a Declaration of Candidacy for the District 4 City Council Office, and pursuant to Election Code Section 10229, Mr. Reyes was appointed-in-lieu by the City Council on August 18, 2020, thereby eliminating the necessity of including that office on the ballot.

With regard to the two proposed tax measures, Measure R, a proposed cannabis excise tax, was passed by voters with 9,529 votes (59.11%) in favor and 6,591 (40.89%) against; while Measure S, a proposed increase in the City's transient occupancy tax or hotel tax, failed with 8,384 (52.55%) votes against, and 7,571 (47.45%) votes in favor.

A copy of Tulare County Registrar of Voter's Certified Statement of Vote is attached hereto as Attachment 1. A draft Resolution accepting the official certified canvass is also attached for the Council's consideration. It is now in order for the City Council to accept the Official Certified Canvass.

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council approve the draft Resolution accepting the Certified Canvass of the November 3, 2020, Municipal General Election from the Tulare County Registrar of Voters.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Porterville duly called a Municipal Election for Tuesday, November 3, 2020, to fill one four-year term office of City Council in District Three, and one four-year term office of City Council in District Five; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Porterville duly called a Special Election for Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting for approval or rejection Measure R, a proposed cannabis business excise tax; and Measure S, a proposed increase in the City's transient occupancy tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10400 et seq., the City Council ordered the consolidation of the November 3, 2020, election with other elections being held in the jurisdiction, and requested that Tulare County Elections Office provide services for said election; and

WHEREAS, only one individual, Monte Reyes, qualified and filed a Declaration of Candidacy for the one available four-year term city council office in District Four, and pursuant to the provisions of Elections Code Section 10229, was appointed-in-lieu on August 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Tulare County Registrar of Voters has certified the canvass and election results of the November 3, 2020, consolidated election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Porterville that the City of Porterville does hereby accept the Official Canvass of Votes of the Consolidated

General Election of November 3, 2020, as Certified by the Tulare County Registrar of Voters on November 30, 2020, as follows:
